Paul Pivovarnik called the meeting to order with a roll call and the pledge of allegiance

Roll Call showed the following Members of Council present: Larry Celaschi, Nancy Ellis, Kristin Hopkins, Jerry Jericho, Paul Pivovarnik Thomas Santoro, and Joseph Smith

Also, present were: Solicitor John Petrisek, Borough Manager Joseph Manning, and Borough Secretary Tammy Greco.

Domenick Carroll, Community Development Manager from Omni Fiber gave a presentation under the recommendation of the Mon Valley Chamber of Commerce. Omni Fiber will be installing lines to offer internet service in Quarter 2 of 2027 at \$60/month approximately.

PUBLIC DISCUSSION ON AGENDA ITEMS:

Robin Borne Robinson, Adjutant of the Charleroi American Legion Post 22 and American Legion Riders, retired US Marine Corps and US Army Reserve, spoke regarding the Memorial Wall. There does not seem to be a process in place to have a name placed on the Memorial Wall. She is offering her services to develop a standard operating procedure that can be shared with others.

Bill Hecklick introduced himself and is currently on the Board of the Historical Society and is willing to the aid the Borough of Charleroi in any way he can.

Finance: Thomas Santoro spoke that they are making adjustments with Tammy to get ready for a Budget meeting and ready to work with Joe regarding the sweeper and truck.

Public Works: Thomas Santoro gave report and Ed Brown, Street Department Supervisor, stated they have 5 Summer help employees that started on Monday, June 8, 2026.

Parks and Recreation/Community Outreach: Jerry Jericho commented on how nice the basketball courts look at Oakland and Crest parks. He is worried about the dirt bikes and E-bikes making marks and tearing up the parks. Oakland Park received water today but still does not electric.

She noted the Food Bank is located at St. Andrew the Apostle Church and is open the 2nd Tuesday of the month. Ezekiel's Closet is located at the United Methodist Church and is open on Thursdays from 11:00-1:30pm. The United Methodist Church is celebrating their 135th Anniversary.

June 27th beginning at 3pm is Magic City Days and Nancy mentioned all the sponsors, vendors and music line up. Nancy stated she should hear soon about the Gazebo to be placed at 3rd and McKean. She thanked Kristin, Tom and Greater Charleroi Community Development Corp.

Community Planning: Kristin Hopkins noted they are working on the Streetscape Grant and a business outreach, with the owners of businesses in Charleroi, later in June. She thanked the Greater Charleroi Community Development Corp.

Code, Fire EMS and Animal Control: Bobby Whiten gave the Fire Report and said the trucks need serviced and they need money. 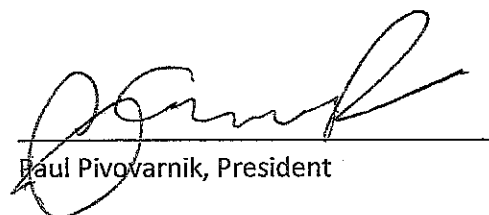
ANNOUNCEMENTS
